



Medication Split-Fill Program for 2020

In 2020, True Health New Mexico will partner with CVS Caremark on a program that will limit initial fills of certain high-risk medications and oncology medications to two 15-day supplies. After the first two 15-day supplies are used, the full prescribed quantity will be covered at one time. This program will work to ensure that members can tolerate these medications and may reduce potential waste.
